

COOPERATIVE AGREEMENTS WITH OTHER COMPONENTS OF STATEWIDE WORKFORCE INVESTMENT SYSTEM

DVR is located as a partner in 11 Comprehensive One Stop job Center locations in the State. Operating agreements exist with WIA partners whenever colocated. In addition to the 11 comprehensive One Stop Job Centers, DVR has 30 additional service locations throughout Wisconsin. DVR staff is able to provide services in most locations in the State using available remote access technology.

An MOU exists between DVR and the Department of Children and Families. The purpose of this MOU is for the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development, Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR) and the Department of Children and Families, Division of Family Supports (DFS), Wisconsin Works (W-2) Program to establish collaborative efforts regarding services to W-2 program participants with disabilities. The MOU establishes a common understanding regarding the respective roles, policies, and procedures of the cooperating agencies to better serve W-2 participants with disabilities who may benefit from services from both programs.
