JUNE LOCAL JOBS DATA, EMPLOYMENT RATES ANNOUNCED

MADISON – Department of Workforce Development (DWD) Secretary Roberta Gassman today released preliminary June 2010 unemployment rates for Wisconsin cities, counties, and metropolitan areas.

"The seasonal increase in unemployment that we're seeing in June is expected as students finish the school year and enter the job market. Statewide, every June over the past 10 years experienced an unemployment rate increase without seasonal adjustment," Secretary Gassman said. "Even so, too many hard-working Wisconsinites remain out of work, and we will continue doing everything we can to help them find good-paying jobs."

Compared with a year ago, the June 2010 rates were either lower or unchanged in all but five Wisconsin counties, as were June 2010 rates in 30 of Wisconsin's 31 largest municipalities and in all 12 metro areas.

Ten metropolitan statistical areas (MSAs) added jobs on a non-seasonally adjusted basis, with Appleton leading the way with 2,100 over the month. The Madison area was next with 1,600 new jobs over the month, while Green Bay and Milwaukee-Waukesha-West Allis each added 1,300 jobs. With seasonal adjustment, six metro areas either held the line or added jobs in June.

UNEMPLOYMENT RATES (NOT SEASONALLY ADJUSTED)

COUNTIES

Twelve Wisconsin counties – many of them in areas that see busy tourism activity during the summer – saw their unemployment rates drop or remain unchanged in June. Vilas County saw the largest drop, to 8.1 percent from 9.2 percent in May, followed by Door County at 8.0 percent from 8.6 percent. The remaining counties experienced an unemployment rate increase.

METRO AREAS

All Wisconsin metropolitan areas experienced a seasonal bump in unemployment in June. Madison had the lowest rate (5.9 percent), followed by La Crosse (6.2 percent) and Eau Claire (6.9 percent). Every MSA posted a lower unemployment rate in June 2010 than one year earlier.

MUNICIPALITIES

Of 31 Wisconsin municipalities with at least 25,000 people, Sheboygan and Menomonee Falls village saw their unemployment rate unchanged in June. Manitowoc saw a drop to 10.2 percent from 10.3 percent in May. The remaining 28 municipalities experienced increases.
