
*NOW, THEREFORE*, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, do hereby proclaim October 2013, as

### DISABILITY EMPLOYMENT AWARENESS MONTH


throughout the State of Wisconsin, and I commend this observance to all of our citizens.
