Labor Law Clinics are educational seminars focusing on topics chosen by local employers, such as the basics of Wisconsin's Fair Employment Law, workplace harassment, deciding eligibility for unemployment benefits, and understanding the principles of Wisconsin's worker's compensation law.

- **Preparing for Unemployment Insurance Appeals Hearings**
- **An Overview of Wisconsin's Labor Standards Law**

Presentations provide an initial orientation to the topic. Speakers are "hands-on" experts working within the program area and are available to respond to a wide range of questions about their programs.
