Informed choice

You have the right to choose your job goal and the services you need to reach your goal. DVR will give you – and help you find – what you need to make informed choices. You will work with DVR to make decisions about your Employment Plan. **If you don't understand something, ask!**

- A family member, a friend or an advocate can help make choices about your DVR services.
- You can get assessments that will help you and DVR know:
 1. If you are eligible for DVR services.
 2. Your waiting list category.
 3. What services you will need to reach your job goal.
- You can make choices about your Employment Plan:
 1. Job goal.
 2. DVR services you need.
 3. Service providers.
 4. Where you get services.
- DVR can give you information about service providers and help you choose the one that will work for you:
 1. What services they have.
 2. Their qualifications.
 3. Cost.
 4. What other consumers have said about the services.
 5. If the service provider has helped other consumers reach their job goals.
- You will work with DVR to choose the best way to buy the services you need to reach your job goal.
- DVR will give you information so you can understand it. Tell DVR:
 1. The best way to contact you – phone, mail, e-mail, etc.
 2. If you need information in an alternate format or translated to another language.
