

Ticket to Work Local Employment Network List

You told DVR that you receive SSI and/or SSDI benefits, so we are giving you a list of local Employment Networks (ENs) for the Ticket to Work Program. These ENs may be able to help you reach your employment goal and/or maintain your current employment. You are eligible for the Ticket to Work Program (TTW) if you are between the ages of 18-64 and receive SSI or SSDI benefits.

ENs can determine which Ticket-holders they want to work with based on an assessment of their services, expertise, capacity, and the Ticket-holder's goals. Do not get discouraged if an EN cannot help you. You should contact the next EN on the list.
