In Wisconsin it is illegal to discriminate in renting or selling because of:

SEX RACE

COLOR SEXUAL ORIENTATION

**DISABILITY** RELIGION

NATIONAL ORIGIN MARITAL STATUS

FAMILY STATUS AGE

LAWFUL SOURCE OF INCOME ANCESTRY

STATUS AS A VICTIM OF DOMESTIC ABUSE, SEXUAL ABUSE OR STALKING
