



Clicking either link opens Webi in a new window. Once logged on the user will navigate to the report.




Relaxed the validation on 'Qualifying Dislocation Date' (Manage Programs)

There was a WIA validation that restricted staff from entering a Qualifying Dislocation Date too far in the past or future, that is no longer a WIOA regulation. Any reasonable date can now be entered into 'Qualifying Dislocation Date' field without causing this error message.

### Follow-Up Status 'Exclusion Reason' field is now Disabled


The 'Exclusion Reason' field on the Follow-Up Status is now disabled for entry:



If an exclusion reason was recorded in the past it will still display, but the field is no longer enabled for choices.


### O\*net code auto-populates when using Edge Browser

## Changes to MSFW questions in JCW - RESEA Assessment

Question 47 – If answered as "No", it will populate (ASSET) Manage Programs Title 3 tab both Eligible Migrant and Seasonal Farmworker Status and Migrant Seasonal Farm Worker fields.

If answered "Yes", a dropdown will appear and user must choose "Seasonal" or "Migrant". This will populate the Migrant Seasonal Farm Worker field.


