



ASSET Changes Implemented

The following changes to ASSET will be implemented on **April 28, 2020**.


Search for Customers by Logon ID

Staff can now search for customers by their JCW logon ID:

If logon ID is found, the record will be displayed in search results. Logon ID is displayed on JCW tab of Manage Customer.

"Unemployed more than 27 consecutive weeks" Field added to Youth Manage Programs

A field to capture "Unemployed more than 27 consecutive weeks" was added to the Youth Program screen. It is a required field, and defaults to 'No Response'. Changes to this field are recorded in Event History.

This new field is located just under the "Individual Income Previous 6 Months" field, consistent with where it appears in the Adult and Dislocated Worker program tabs:

Production System Fixes

- Staff can again uncheck the correctional facility inmate checkbox in Asset for DOC Inmates who are being released. This function was inadvertently affected by other development work.
- NAICS code fields can allow alpha characters - In the past, all NAICS (North American Industry Classification System) codes released by the BLS (Bureau of Labor Statistics) have been numeric-only. In the latest dataset some of the codes now contain letters. ASSET now allows NAICS codes with alphanumeric characters.
