


# ASSET Technical Bulletin

## ASSET Changes – Will be deployed on April 3, 2024

### QUEST participant improvements

- The checkbox on the Title 1 – Dislocated Worker program has been updated from "QUEST participant" to "QUEST participant under age 18" to clarify its correct usage.

- Additionally, when this optional checkbox has been selected, the fund sources on added services will be limited to the "DWG Funded Grant" fund source to ensure proper program participation.




The screenshot shows a dropdown menu for fund sources. The 'DWG Funded Grant' option is selected and highlighted with a blue background.

### Title 1 improvements

- Keeping in line with WIOA policy updates, the Title 1 program eligibility calculations will no longer allow a customer to lose eligibility if they lose their work authorization status.

### Title 3 – JVSG improvements

- To clarify the difference in meaning, one of the two JVSG program fields labeled "Active Duty Military Spouse" has been re-named to "Eligible Spouse." The Eligible Spouse field represents if the customer meets any of the criteria that makes them an eligible spouse, whereas the Active Duty Military Spouse field represents if the customer is currently the spouse of someone on active duty.
