Depending on our ever-changing hiring needs, Monarch Paving Company would most likely be in need to hire one to eight of the following:

- 1-5 Newly trained entry level Heavy Equipment workers that successfully complete the training at an average starting wage of \$23.79 per hour, plus benefits.
- <u>1-4</u> Newly skilled/experienced CDL trainees that successfully complete the program at an average starting wage of \$23.79 per hour, plus benefits.

The training project will not result in any dislocation of company employees from their current place of employment. The increased skills training will benefit the trainees involved and is in response to a skills shortage experienced by both our company and the construction industry as a whole.

The company does not anticipate any circumstances, financial or legal, barring the company from meeting its commitments as presented in the project proposal but again is based on our hiring needs.
