



CBRF COMMUNITY BASED RESIDENTIAL TRAINING

Medication Administration: 10 hrs - \$300

***2 Day Course Thursday-Friday 9:00AM-4:00PM**

Participants will learn about the six rights of medication administration, facility policies and procedures, delegated procedures, medication management, medical terms and abbreviations, medication packaging, labeling and storage, the various types and codes of medications and how to properly administer and document the administration of medication. This course is taught by a Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse

Standard Precautions: 2hrs. - \$125

*** OFFERED TWICE WEEKLY Mondays 9:00am-11:00am Weds 1:30-3:30pm**

Participants will learn the importance of standard precautions in the workplace. Participants will learn and understand how bloodborne diseases and other communicable diseases spread from person to person as well as how to prevent the spread of communicable diseases with handwashing and Personal Protective Equipment. This course is taught by a Licensed Practical Nurse

First Aid & Choking: 4 hrs - \$150

***Tuesdays 9:00am-1:30pm**

This state-approved course will help participants learn how to identify and respond properly to a choking adult, child, or infant according to the American Red Cross guidelines. Participants will learn to recognize emergencies and respond appropriately using First Aid techniques. This course is taught by a Licensed Practical Nurse

Fire Safety: 5hrs - \$150

***Mondays 11:30am-3:30pm**

Wednesdays 9:00am-1:00pm

Participants will learn to understand the nature of fire, recognize fire hazards, learn about early warning systems, understand the use of fire extinguishers, focus on the evacuation needs of Residents, follow the CBRF emergency and disaster plan, and respond in an emergency. This course is taught by a Registered Nurse or Licensed Practical Nurse

Successful completion of the above courses will place student on CBRF state registry



Adult CPR/AED 4 hr - \$100

***Tuesdays 5:00pm-9:00pm/Also request class on demand available**

This training teaches how to respond to adults with cardiac emergencies by using CPR chest compressions and rescue breathing and also how to use an automated external defibrillator(AED). This class is offered to various fields of service Health Care, Childcare, Factory etc. Adult CPR/AED is taught according to American Heart Association standards

Residents Rights \$75 2hr

Resident rights are extremely important because they protect a vulnerable population. This course will teach you how to remain in compliance with state laws governing residents right. This course is taught by a Licensed Practical Nurse.

Challenging Behaviors \$75 2hr

This course will teach students how to effectively care for residents with different health Diagnosis and Challenging Behaviors. This course is taught by a Licensed Practical Nurse students will learn proven techniques and pathology of the disease process and the behaviors associated with them

Assessment & ISP \$75 2hrs

This course will teach students proper documentations and assessment skills which is the foundation of a healthcare professional. This course is taught by a Licensed Practical Nurse. Students will learn how to properly recognize and document incidents and assessments in the CBRF setting.

Healthcare Etiquette and Dietary 101 3hrs \$75

This course will teach students Professional and Healthcare etiquette including HIPAA and healthcare related customer service. Students will learn guidelines and food service requirements according to DHS 83. This course is taught by a Licensed Practical Nurse.
