To earn this 120-credit RN to BSN degree, you'll need to complete 60 credits. Your own dedicated Success Coach will work with you throughout the program to create a personalized learning plan.

BSN Courses

You will need to complete a minimum of **30 nursing credits (21 core credits + 9 advanced nursing elective credits)** to earn your BSN. All BSN courses are 3 credits.
