Dear Members of the Dislocated Worker Unit:

Western Industries, Inc. will be permanently closing its entire production operations located at 1141 South 10th Street, Watertown, Wisconsin 53094. As a result of this planned closure, approximately 85 employees will be permanently laid off. The District Lodge No. 10 of the International Association of Machinists and Aerospace Workers, AFL-CIO represents all hourly production and maintenance employees at the affected plant. Layoffs will commence sometime between July 16, 2018 and July 29, 2018 and should be completed by October 29, 2018. Affected employees will not have bumping or transfer rights.
