Re: Plant Closure

Dear Members of the Dislocated Workers Unit:

I regret to inform you that Prinsco, Inc. will be permanently ceasing production and closing its plant located at 510 N Lilas Drive in Appleton, Wisconsin 54914. The closure has been prompted by the company's decision to consolidate manufacturing at other locations. We will be relocating our warehousing / yard operations to a new site in Wisconsin.

As the result of this action, 33 positions will be eliminated. The company expects to begin eliminating positions on February 4, 2019 and will continue until the plant is completely closed and the yard relocated by January 2020.

Attached is a list of job titles, number affected within each job title, and the anticipated layoff dates for salaried and hourly workers. While we have offered transfers to other plants, it is impossible to predict with certainty which employees may accept transfers and which employees will be separated. The company will ensure that all earned wages and benefits will be paid at the time of termination.
