Pursuant to the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act, 29 U.S.C. § 2101 *et. seq.* (1988) and Wisconsin's Business Closing and Mass Layoff Law, this is to inform you that The Journal Times, 212 Fourth Street, Racine, WI 53403 plans to initiate a "mass layoff."
