Re Announcement of Planned Action

Dear Department of Workforce Development:

We are writing to give you notice that there will be a total closure of the Bear Down Logistics Central Sussex facility located at N53W24700 S Corporate Cir in Sussex, Wisconsin on April 13, 2020. The entire facility will be closed and all employees at the facility will be impacted. This closure is expected to be permanent. The expected date of the first separation will be April 13, 2020.

All affected employees have been notified of their separation dates and that their separation from employment will be permanent. Those employees are expected to be separated from employment beginning on April 13, 2020, with all separations accomplished on that date. There are 95 employees at this location that will be impacted.

There will not be any bumping rights for the affected employees, that is, employees will not be able to displace more junior employees out of their job positions as a result of this closure. There is no union representing affected employees.
