Re: Notice of Business Closing – Cascio Music Co., Inc.

Dear Members of the Dislocated Workers Unit:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that Cascio Music Co., Inc. d/b/a Cascio Interstate Music ("Cascio" or the "Company") has been placed into receivership by Court Order pursuant to Chapter 128 of the Wisconsin Statutes.

I have been appointed by the Court as the Chapter 128 Receiver of the Company, and as such, I should be considered the Company official for purposes of this notice. I have been authorized to operate Cascio in the ordinary course pending sale of the Company's assets. There will be on-going efforts to locate a buyer for the Company and operate the Company as a going concern until such time a suitable buyer can be located. However, in the event that a suitable buyer cannot be located, Cascio will be forced to close its business and permanently cease operations.

As a result, Cascio, located at 13819 W. National Ave., New Berlin, Wisconsin, 53151, is providing you this notice, pursuant to the Wisconsin Business Closing and Mass Layoff law, Wis. Stat. § 109.07, that it is planning to close its entire business and permanently cease operations on April 20, 2020.

The permanent closing of Cascio on April 20, 2020 will result in the permanent elimination of 71 job positions effective as of the date of the permanent closure.

Cascio will ensure that all terminated employees will be paid all earned wages and agreed upon benefits at the time of their termination, consistent with the procedures of Wis. Ch. 128.
