Re Announcement of Planned Action

To Whom it May Concern:


As a result of the unforeseeable, dramatic downturn in business and occupancy caused by the coronavirus natural disaster, we are writing to inform you that there will be a mass layoff at the Holiday Inn Convention Center Stevens Point, 1001 Amber Ave., Stevens Point, WI, 54482 on March 21, 2020. This mass layoff is expected to be temporary. The expected date of the first separation will be March 21, 2020.

All 143 affected employees have been notified of their separation dates and that their separation from employment will be temporary. Those employees are expected to be separated from employment beginning on March 21, 2020 with all separations accomplished by March 25, 2020.

There will not be any bumping rights for affected employees—that is, employees will not be able to displace more junior employees out of their job positions as a result of this closure.
