In accordance with federal and state WARN requirements, Wisconsin Central School Bus is providing notification of the temporary layoff at our facility in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. The temporary layoff is a direct result of the Wisconsin Department of Health Services' order to close schools. The employees will be recalled as soon as school resumes.

The Company is officially notifying the local elected official, the state, and our employees of the temporary layoff at the Milwaukee location starting on or about March 16, 2020. This temporary layoff will affect approximately 90 part-time employees.
