Mayor: on behalf of my client, Christopher j. murphy (president of eddie martini's enterprises) and its related business entities, this will notify you that on march 17, 2020, eddie martini's temporarily laid off a total of 30 employees at our existing business address of 8612 w. watertown plank rd, Wauwatosa, 53226.

**The facility remains open and there has been no business closing.**

The duration of these layoffs cannot presently be estimated because they were prompted by the outbreak of CV-19; a situation which remains in flux.

All such employees will be paid all wages due in accordance with applicable law. The employees are not represented by a union and do not have bumping rights. We have also notified the Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development of this mass layoff.

Additional information concerning this mater can be obtained by contacting me personally.

Eddie martini's is aware that Wisconsin encourages employers to provide voluntary notice of dislocation vents which do not require that notice be provided. Accordingly, this letter should not be construed as an admission of coverage under 29 U.S.C. &2101 et seq. or Wis. Stat & 109.07 or 109.075.
