Dear Members of the Dislocated Worker Unit:

The YMCA of Dodge County has temporarily laid off a large percentage of its workforce at the location listed below in response to temporary closures mandated by Wisconsin legislatures. The duration of these closures remains unknown due to the rapidly changing responses of legislatures. We are still providing emergency early childhood care and school age care at both of this location for essential workers.

On March 17, 2020 we notified 89 part-time hourly (non-exempt employees) that they we had to close our facilities as of March 18, 2020. We informed them that we would be repurposing our facilities for emergency child care and would keep them posted on when we could re-open our facilities.

As responses to the pandemic continue to rapidly evolve, so shall our response with regard to staffing. Regardless of the response, The YMCA of Dodge County will ensure that employees will be paid all earned wages and agreed upon benefits at the time of layoff.
