Re: Notice of APL Logistics' Kenosha Facility Closure

I am writing on behalf of APL Logistics Warehouse Management Services, Inc. ("APLL") to provide notice that there will be a total closure of the APLL Kenosha facility located at 9800 72nd Ave, Pleasant Prairie, WI 53158 on October 31, 2020. The entire facility will close, and the closure is expected to be permanent.

The expected last date of employment at the Kenosha facility will be October 31, 2020, with all employment separations taking place on that date. All affected employees have been notified of their separation dates and that their separation from employment will be permanent.

The following is a list of the job positions and number of individuals who will be affected by the facility closure with all employment separations occurring on October 31, 2020.
