To Whom It May Concern:

In response to competitive pressures and contract changes in the federal government contracts market, Wisconsin Physicians Service Insurance Corporation ("WPS") is reducing resources across the corporation at the following Monona and Wausau locations:

Madison, WI Campus\*: 1717 W. Broadway, Madison, WI 53713  
Rothschild, WI: 1480 County Road XX, Suite 110, Rothschild, WI 54474

(\*Please note that this campus of buildings is located in the City of Monona, but utilizes a Madison mailing address.)

The expected date of the first separation is May 3, 2021. WPS expects that 36 employees at the Monona location and 92 employees at the Rothschild location will be affected. WPS anticipates that this action will be permanent. A list of job titles of the positions affected and the number of employees in each position will be maintained on site and readily accessible upon request.

This notice is intended to comply with the notice obligations, if any, of WPS under the federal Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act ("WARN Act") and the Wisconsin Business Closing and Mass Layoff Law, Wis. Stat. § 109.07 ("Wisconsin WARN Act"). However, the giving of this notice shall not constitute an acknowledgement by WPS of any obligations under the WARN Act or the Wisconsin WARN Act in the event the effects of the plant closing described in this notice are such that the requirements of the WARN Act or the Wisconsin WARN Act do not apply.
