Re: **St. Croix Meadows – Letter to RESCIND Conditional WARN Notice**

Dear Sir or Madam:

On July 1, 2022, Phillips-Medisize, LLC (“Phillips”) notified this office of a conditional workforce reduction event pursuant to the regulations of the Worker Adjustment and Retraining Notification Act (“WARN,” 20 CFR Section 639.7). In that notice, Phillips laid out the possibility of an employment loss event sufficient to trigger the requirements of WARN, if certain conditions came to pass. By this letter, Phillips notifies you that those conditions have not and are now not reasonably likely to come to pass, and therefore **Phillips rescinds its July 1, 2022, Conditional WARN Notice.**

Because the conditions necessary to make Phillips subject to the WARN Act did not in fact occur, Phillips respectfully requests this office remove the July 1, 2022, Conditional WARN Notice from its public website, or, in the alternative, additionally publish this letter indicating that the Conditional WARN Notice has been rescinded.
