
NOW, THEREFORE, I, Scott Walker, Governor of the State of Wisconsin,

STATE EMPLOYEE RECOGNITION DAY


throughout the State of Wisconsin and I encourage all citizens to express appreciation to our state employees for their hard work, dedication, and commitment to public service.
