

# Confidentiality

Information in your DVR record is confidential. Personal information you give DVR will not be shared with anyone without your written consent.

**There are some exceptions. DVR can release personal information about you:**

- To coordinate your DVR services with other agencies that can help you reach your job goal
- If the information is needed for a criminal investigation
- If the Wisconsin Child Support Program asks for it
- If your counselor thinks you may hurt yourself or others
- To report child abuse or neglect
- To report elder abuse or neglect
- In response to a court order
- For an audit – auditors will see confidential information, but your personal information will not be used in any of their reports
