

Your Ticket to Work Services

Because you receive Social Security monthly benefits, you have a Ticket to Work from the Social Security Administration (SSA). Your Ticket is not a piece of paper; it is connected to your Social Security number.

You may be able to use your Ticket to receive services from an Employment Network (EN) to help you find or keep a job. ENs are service providers, education and training programs, government agencies, and employers approved by Social Security to help you find or keep a job.

While you are on the DVR waiting list, you can contact ENs to see if they can help you. Even if you work with an Employment Network, you will still be eligible for DVR services and your time on the waiting list will not change.
