

Your Ticket to Work Services

Congratulations on reaching your employment goal with DVR!

Because you receive Social Security monthly benefits, you have a Ticket to Work from the Social Security Administration (SSA). Your Ticket is not a piece of paper; it is connected to your Social Security number.

You may be able to use your Ticket to receive services from an Employment Network (EN) to support you while you are working. Employment Networks are service providers, education and training programs, government agencies, and employers approved by Social Security.

Now that you have completed your DVR services, you can contact ENs to learn how they can help **support you keeping your job or getting a better job**. Your DVR employment congratulations letter can be used as proof that your DVR case was closed successfully and that your Ticket is available to an EN for additional services.
