

Student Earned Income Exclusion

General Information

- ▶ The Student Earned Income Exclusion (SEIE) allows portions of a student's gross income to be excluded when figuring out their Supplemental Security Income (SSI) cash benefit amount.
- ▶ SEIE decreases the amount of countable earned income allowing students to keep more of their SSI check when working.
- ▶ Decreases fears for both students and family and students when they try working.

Qualification Requirements

In order to qualify, an individual must be:

- ▶ Under the age of 22.
- ▶ Receiving SSI payments due to their disability.
- ▶ Regularly attending school.
