

Unemployment Insurance 1099-G Tax Information



Your 1099-G income tax statement shows:

- Unemployment Insurance (UI) benefits paid to you,
- Federal and state income taxes withheld from your UI benefits, and;
- Repayments of overpaid UI benefits.

UI benefits are taxable income reported to the Wisconsin Department of Revenue (DOR) and Internal Revenue Service (IRS).

To view or print your 1099-G form for the most recent tax year (available mid-January):

- Log on to your Claimant Portal at my.unemployment.wisconsin.gov
- Go to "My UI Home"
- Choose "Get your 1099-G"

To view or print your 1099-G forms for prior years:

- Log on to your Claimant Portal at my.unemployment.wisconsin.gov
- Go to "My UI Summary"
- Choose "1099-G Tax Information" (under "Other Resources")
