Thank you for notifying the Regional Office on May 11, 2015 of Wisconsin's intent to extend its PY 2014 performance goals into PY 2015. As referenced in Training and Employment Guidance Letter No. 30-14, ETA allowed states to extend all currently negotiated PY 2014 goals going forward into PY 2015 to provide for an orderly transition from the Workforce Investment Act (WIA) to the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA).

This letter serves as official notification advising Wisconsin of its WIA and Wagner-Peyser Act (WP) PY 2015 performance goals. A copy of the negotiated goals is enclosed with this letter.

This official notice also constitutes a modification to the State Integrated Workforce Plan.
