The H2A Population Report reflects the number of foreign workers that were approved for temporary agricultural hire to fill jobs essential to the U.S. economy. Employers obtained certification when they demonstrated that there were insufficient qualified U.S. workers available and willing to perform the work at wages that meet or exceed the prevailing wage paid for that occupation in the area of intended employment.
