BLS Data: Wisconsin Unemployment Rate Remains at 2.9 Percent in March

Wisconsin adds 9,200 total non-farm, 12,400 private-sector jobs from March 2018 – March 2019

MADISON — The Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development (DWD) today released the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS) preliminary employment estimates for the month of March. The data show that Wisconsin added 9,200 total non-farm jobs and 12,400 private-sector jobs from March 2018 to March 2019. Wisconsin's unemployment rate remained at 2.9 percent in March and Wisconsin's labor force participation rate remained at 67.5 percent.

In brief:

- **Place of Residence Data:** Wisconsin's preliminary, seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in March was 2.9 percent. The national unemployment rate in March was 3.8 percent. Wisconsin's labor force participation rate for March was 67.5 percent.
- **Place of Work Data:** Wisconsin added 9,200 total non-farm jobs and 12,400 private-sector jobs from March 2018 to March 2019. Wisconsin private-sector employment decreased 4,500 from Feb. 2019 to March 2019. Total non-farm employment decreased by 1,800 over the same time period.

"The data released by BLS today underscores the importance that our programming and policies prioritize economic progress for all Wisconsin families and businesses," DWD Secretary-designee Caleb Frostman said. "With our state's low unemployment rate and growing workforce shortage, we must ensure all Wisconsinites can support themselves and their families from a fair wage under fair working conditions, while also attracting new workers to our state and back into the workforce. That's why I support Governor Evers' 2019-2021 Budget, which removes barriers to employment, provides targeted training, and makes Wisconsin a more attractive place to live and work."
