# **BLS Data: September Wisconsin Employment Numbers Released**

MADISON – The Wisconsin Department of Workforce Development (DWD) today announced 3,057,100 total nonfarm jobs in the state, according to September 2025 preliminary estimates from the U.S. Bureau of Labor Statistics.

Preliminary employment estimates for September 2025 showed Wisconsin's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate remained unchanged at 3.1%, which is 1.3 percentage points below the national unemployment rate of 4.4%. The state's labor force participation rate decreased to 64.5% in September while the national rate increased to 62.4%, marking Wisconsin's participation rate 2.1 percentage points above the rest of the nation.

- Place of Residence Data: Wisconsin's unemployment rate was 3.1% in September, 1.3 percentage points below the national rate of 4.4%. Wisconsin's labor force decreased by 11,400 over the month and is down 51,500 over the year. The number of people employed decreased 10,100 over the month to 3,035,300 employed and is down 51,800 over the year.
- Place of Work Data: Total nonfarm jobs decreased 9,800 over the month and increased 17,700 over the year to 3,057,100 jobs.
