## Claimant Online Services and Contact Information

### Apply for Benefits Online

*For a New Claim or to Reopen an Existing Claim*

1. Go to [my.unemployment.wisconsin.gov](http://my.unemployment.wisconsin.gov)
2. Read and accept terms and conditions.
3. Create a username and password.  
 You may need to verify your identity as part of this step. If you need to verify your identity, you will not be able to file a claim until your identity is verified.
4. Log on to access your Claimant Portal.
5. Complete your initial claim application.

*Access Your Claim Information Online*

1. Go to [my.unemployment.wisconsin.gov](http://my.unemployment.wisconsin.gov)
2. Log on to view and manage your claim information online:
  - Check your claim status.
  - View or print your payment history.
  - Check status of eligibility issues or appeals.
  - View or print determinations.
  - and more!

2. Log on to access your Claimant Portal.
3. File your weekly claim.
