We are pleased to report that during the first quarter of 1997, all insurers and self insurers reached a combined promptness of first payment level of 81 percent.

Our records indicate that during the first quarter your company had a total of <total> claims, <prompt> were prompt which resulted in a promptness of first payment percentage of <:number>.

The goal of the Worker's Compensation Division is to have insurers and self-insurers maintain a promptness of first payment level of 80 percent or better. The above figures indicate your company was not at that level on an average, during the first quarter of 1997.

For the first quarter of 1997 your promptness ratio was below 75 percent. It is imperative that corrective action be instituted in order to meet or exceed the 80 percent standard [Wisconsin Administrative Code, IND 80.02(2) and (3)] in order to avoid future fines and penalties.
