Thank you for inquiring about providing vocational rehabilitation services to worker's compensation claimants.

The Worker's Compensation Division refers injured workers who are determined eligible for services by the Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR) to private, certified counselors. To become a certified private vocational rehabilitation counselor, you must complete the enclosed application and return it along with a copy of your current resume. Private vocational rehabilitation counselors must possess national professional certification or a Wisconsin professional license to become certified. Therefore, please submit a photocopy of your current professional certifications and/or professional counselor license along with your completed application.

Certified vocational rehabilitation counselors must be capable of providing worker's compensation claimants with a full range of services that will return them to work. Since job placement is the major focus of vocational rehabilitation, you must be able to develop a training plan and also be capable of carrying it out.
