of Wisconsin State Agencies that Regulate Training Programs

Please Note: Wisconsin's Educational Approval Program (EAP) is located within Wisconsin's Department of Safety and Professional Services and is created by Wisconsin state statute. The EAP regulates most private entities (including those based outside of Wisconsin) that offer occupational training and educational programs to Wisconsin residents. The table, below, shows some common examples of training program types and the Wisconsin state agencies that regulate them.
