Welcome to the DWD Cornerstone Learning Center for Wisconsin, a place where you can search for and enroll in training or events, launch online training, and view and print your training records.

To browse for sessions, go to the "Learning" drop down menu and click on the "Browse for Training" subtab. You can browse for training via: Competency, the Events (Training) Calendar, or by clicking on the "Go to Search" link. You can also view Your Upcoming Sessions, as well as Suggested Training.

From the Events Calendar Page, you can view available sessions by Day, Week, or Month. Another good way to find available training sessions is by typing in the name of the training you are searching for and clicking the Search icon. If you do not know the name of the training you are searching for, perform a blank search by just clicking the Search icon.

When you locate a session you are interested in attending, click on the course title and then click on the "Request" button in the pop up page. After you have completed the necessary steps to register and pay for your training, you will see your training session status listed as "Registered" in your Transcript under the "Active" tab. You'll receive an email notification which will provide additional session details. You can also launch and complete online training from your Transcript.


